## Financial Scholarship Guidelines

The Board of Directors of The Charleston Youth Company recognize that circumstances occur in these economic times that make it difficult for parents to pay for an extracurricular activity for their child to participate in. We feel strongly that if a child masters the audition to become a member of CYC, we should do all that we can to help that child reach their potential. With our recycling program through PlanetGreen and donations made to the Trident United Way on behalf of CYC, we are able to offer some financial help to those in need.

In order to be considered for a partial scholarship (Tuition Only) we ask that you do all of the following:

- Complete the Scholarship Application Form and submit it prior to the first rehearsal
- Scholarship recipients are required to pay \$100. This should be paid in monthly installments of \$12.50 for 8 months.
- Seek out as many sponsorships as you can from family and friends. Every \$5.00 and \$10.00 sponsorship will help you.
- Seek out and get ads(from businesses) for the CYC Playbill. Information is in your Student Handbook.
- All tickets for the shows MUST be paid for in ADVANCE before they will be given to a child on scholarship.
- Be willing to work extra duties at shows (like be an usher on the night you do not have to work backstage or help with cleaning of warehouse.)
- Be willing to work and help the Black and White Silent Auction Committee procure items. Also agree to work extra hours if you cannot sell 3 tickets
- Understand that your child will be expected to assist the Producer and Director in collecting and packing ink cartridge recycling items, or performing other duties for 15 minutes after every rehearsal(collect music, stack chairs, straighten up)
- Understand that your child will help with regular recycling of all paper, plastic, and cardboard at the rehearsal studio.

The BOD will review your participation in the above activities every month to insure that you and your child are meeting the requirements to continue receiving the tuition scholarship.

If you have any special skills that directly benefit the entire program, the BOD may substitute those skills for some of the requirements listed above. This will be outlined when you meet with the Producer and/or BOD Representative.
