Theater Etiquette

Another exciting season is closing for the Charleston Youth Company! We are thrilled that you are joining us here in the Sottile Theatre to close out our 45th year!

As an avid theatre-goer, I have seen quite a change in the behavior of the audiences these last years. Going to see a live performance on a stage is not like going to see a film at a movie theater. Of course, there are certain dos and don'ts for movie goers as well, but going to see a play requires even more mindfulness of your fellow theater-goers and actors on the stage to ensure that the experience is an enjoyable and memorable one for all. Thank you in advance for making this performance a wonderful experience for all!

Following are guidelines for proper decorum at the theater:

- **1.** Be on time. It shows respect for the actors on the stage and your fellow theater-goers.
- 2. Go to the restroom before you sit down, or at the intermission, not during the performance. It will not only be disruptive to persons seated in your row and the rows around you, but also to the actors on the stage.
- 3. Do not talk during a live performance once it has begun.
- 4. Turn off your cell phone and put it away.
- 5. Be appreciative. Do show your appreciation by clapping at the appropriate times; and standing at the end of the show when all others around you are standing.
- 6. No food or drinks are allowed in this theatre. If you must eat a mint or piece of candy, open it quietly so as not to disturb those around you!
